GOODBYE, MTV (8/1/1981–12/31/2025) – ♪ THE DAY THE MUSIC CHANNEL DIED ♪

Don McLean sang ♪ “*A long, long time ago...*” ♪ in *American Pie* as a eulogy for the 1950s. The 1971 classic cataloged how the turbulent 60s moved Americans from being ♪ “*in one place*” ♪ to a generation adrift, ♪ “*lost in space, with no time left to start again.*” ♪

Ten years later, on [August 1, 1981, at 12:01 AM ET, MTV, a new “space,” launched](#), fittingly, with a rocket . The [Moonman](#) , symbolizing spaceflight and our most powerful form of transportation, became the emblem of a new cultural meeting place for America’s youth, who joined one cable   household at a time.

MTV captured a generation. Music videos became a new form of art and communication. Teens shared the same language, images, heroes, and must-watch premieres. “[I Want My MTV!](#)” became a rallying cry. More than programming, it was a phenomenon.

And now, that era is officially pulling into the station for the last time. [Paramount Global closed five MTV music channels at year-end-2025](#), marking the end of a major chapter in music broadcasting. Our old, shared world is shrinking.

SAYING FAREWELL TO MTV MIGHT SEEM OFF-TOPIC FOR A TRANSPORTATION REPORT. IN FACT, IT'S A MUST-COVER SUBJECT. MTV WAS ABOUT MOTION. MOVEMENT. MACHINES. AND NOT JUST MUSIC. THE THRILL OF GOING SOMEWHERE. THE MUSIC VIDEO WASN'T JUST A CLIP; IT WAS A VEHICLE. MTV DIDN'T JUST SHOW VEHICLES. IT SHOWED WHAT VEHICLES MEANT.

Transportation in MTV videos was metaphor and visual shorthand. “[Little Red Corvette](#)”  was temptation with a warning light underneath. “[I Can't Drive 55](#)”  distilled a generation’s impatience with limits into one speed sign and a foot on the gas. “[Fast Car](#)” was a promise and an escape plan. “[Downtown Train](#)”  carried longing through a city of missed connections. “[The Metro](#)”  captured the lonely truth of mass transit: surrounded by people yet still traveling alone. “[Vacation](#)” 

MTV isn’t one place anymore. It lives now in fragments on social media, everywhere and nowhere, endlessly available but rarely shared at the same exact moment. VJs became   [disc jockeys](#) on  [Sirius XM](#). The streaming era gives us everything on demand, including the way music keeps recycling itself forward. You can hear it when Eminem and Lady Gaga refresh 80s songs for their smashes  “[Houdini](#)” and  “[Abracadabra.](#)” The songs keep moving, even when the platform changes.

If you ever need proof universal youth culture is still possible, look at how quickly “[67](#)” became a ubiquitous catchphrase: [two digits accompanied by a juggling-hand gesture](#) that basically means “okay, old person,” casting Gen X and Millennials as the radio stars [The Buggles warned would be dismissed](#).

♪ “...Video killed the radio star. In my mind and in my car. We can’t rewind, we’ve gone too far.” ♪

[Don't Look Back In Anger](#), not even you [Gallagher brothers](#) and [Oasis](#). We’ll be grateful for our moment and keep driving. MTV taught us what transportation planners already know: every generation finds a new route. Destinations, vehicles, and platforms change. But the need to connect and be together in one place does not.

MTV made generations feel like we were riding together. If one artist embodied that fearless, visual, kinetic spirit, it was [Madonna](#). She was our [True Blue](#)  80s muse, who sang “[Into The Groove](#)” to get us up to dance. MTV gave us the chance. Madonna showed us in 2000, the year of one of her many career rebirths and her cover of [American Pie](#), that there is, in fact, ♪ “*time left to start again.*” ♪ She also reminded us of the whole point of MTV: ♪ “*Music makes the people come together.*” ♪





Fewer Vehicles Entered the Toll Zone



New York City's Sales Tax Receipts Grew Faster Than Nearby Counties



Storefront Vacancies in Congestion Zone Declined Faster


The vacancy rate in the tolled zone dropped by nearly one percentage point in 2025, while the citywide average stayed flat

Waymo:

The most interesting thing about the Waymo blackout mess isn't that robotaxis froze. It's why they froze.

The cars knew exactly what to do. Dead traffic light? Treat it like a four-way stop. Humans do this every day. But Waymo's system still asked a human:

"Hey... are you sure this is okay?"


That worked fine when it was one intersection.

It collapsed when it was the entire city. This is the dirty secret of autonomy (and honestly, AI everywhere): Human-in-the-loop sounds safe... until concurrency hits. Rare edge cases stop being rare when the world misbehaves all at once.

So this wasn't an AI problem. It was an organizational confidence problem. Google style

Waymo didn't trust its own system enough to let it act decisively at scale. The fix isn't better sensors. It's deciding when software no longer needs permission. Autonomy doesn't fail when models are dumb. It fails when humans can't keep up.
